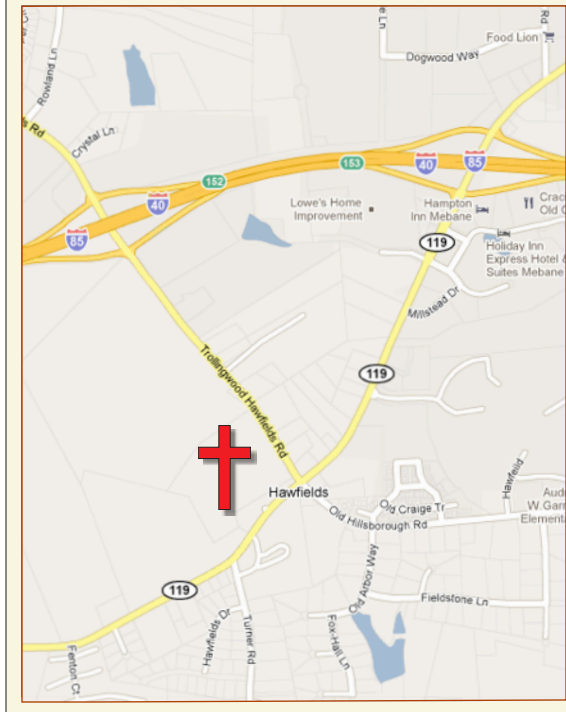




**LET'S SHAPE THEIR

Deuteronomy 6 says, "...Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise. Bind them as a sign on your hand, fix them as an emblem on your forehead, and write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."

We as a congregation promise all of that and more when we Baptize and when we share Communion together. The classes are designed to help us keep this promise in a concrete and lasting way. Parents/Caregivers decide whether their children are ready to engage the Sacraments.

The Lord's Table Class is designed to give parents/caregivers and children alike tools to engage and navigate two important aspects of our tradition and history.



# More Than an Opportunity



## DEEP IN REFORMED THEOLOGY

*Our denomination, the Presbyterian Church (USA) has a great history of talking about God and belief. It is our conviction that children should be engaged in theological conversation at the earliest ages and that they have something to teach us in the process. We also believe that teaching takes place both through intentional and unintentional means. This course is an effort to ensure that intentional conversations about faith take place both at church and at home.*



Done in three Saturday sessions in the Fall (as necessary) and in the Winter, this class uses prayer, games, movie clips, music, computer slides, the catechism, the Bible, and the life experience of adults. Hands on experience with baking and preparing Communion bread as well as a tour of the areas and elements of our sacraments are included. Additional

Each session builds on the next beginning with Baptism. The next session is Communion. The third session combines bread-baking with a tour of the Sacristy and Chancel. The following Sunday our “graduates” assist in worship and experience anew Communion coupled with their learning. For more information contact the church office.



materials including a copy of the lesson plans, supplemental readings and other resources are given to allow the partnership learning-style done in the session to be done at home. At least one parent/caregiver is required to attend each session with their child in order to rehearse in the classroom the kind of conversations that will hopefully take place at home. This is a critical part of the work.
